Setting a public hearing to consider adoption of resolution of necessity for property located at 7891 Ann Arbor Way.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Adopt Resolution No. 10-08 -_____, Setting a Public Hearing to Consider Adoption of a Resolution of Necessity for Property Located at 7891 Ann Arbor Way, Further Identified as Sacramento County Assessor's Parcel Number 053-0141-015.

DISCUSSION

A portion of property located at 7891 Ann Arbor Way, (Sacramento County Assessor's parcel Number 053-0141-015) "the Subject Property" is needed for construction of RT's South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 Project (SSCP2).

On September 22, 2009, pursuant to authority granted by the Board, RT made a formal offer in the amount of its approved appraisal to the owner to purchase a portion of the subject property pursuant to Government Code Section 7267.2. Negotiations with the owner were apparently successful and a Purchase and Sale Agreement was signed. However, the owner has subsequently declined to authorize the title company to contact the lenders for a partial deed of reconveyance needed to conclude the transaction. This authorization is required and can only be given by the owner. Despite numerous attempts made by phone, mail and personal visits to obtain the necessary authorization, the owner has not granted authorization and refuses to speak to RT or its representatives. As a result, this transaction cannot be concluded voluntarily and it appears this acquisition will require resort to the eminent domain process.

State law requires that RT hold a public hearing regarding the intent to adopt a resolution of necessity prior to filing an action in eminent domain, give notice to all persons listed on the last equalized County assessment roll, and allow at least 15 days for owners to respond to the notice. At the hearing, staff will present the need and necessity for the property. Owners and any others with an interest in the property will be given an opportunity to be heard. Adoption of the resolution of necessity requires a two-thirds vote of the Board.
