## DISCUSSION

RT entered into a Contract on July 21, 2009 with The Wong/STV Team (Consultant) to provide Construction Management services for the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 (SSCP2) project. One of the Construction Management services is the analysis, comment and resolution tracking of design issues that may affect the constructability of the project. These Constructability Reviews are performed during the design phase of the project and are a valuable tool to ensure construction of the project can be performed without conflicts that may otherwise be avoided.

Work Order No. 2 was issued on September 4, 2009 and amended on January 29, 2010 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$91,842.00 to compensate Consultant for work related to Constructability Reviews during the preliminary engineering phase of the project. Constructability Reviews have been successfully performed on the preliminary engineering design in accordance with the Work Order.
