DISCUSSION

On April 13, 2009, the RT Board approved the Agreement for Preliminary Engineering Reimbursement (Gas Line) with PG&E for the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 (SSCP2) Project.

RT is proceeding with the advanced preliminary engineering of the SSCP2 Project. The existing PG&E gas line within the Union Pacific Railroad right of way that will be occupied by the Project must be relocated to accommodate Project construction.

The existing PG&E gas line extends through the Union Pacific Railroad Corridor for approximately three-quarters of a mile directly under the proposed 40-foot light rail corridor. To expedite the relocation of the PG&E gas line and to prevent potential delays of the SSCP2 Project, RT requested that PG&E commence preliminary engineering for its relocation, and the Agreement was entered into to compensate PG&E for its preliminary engineering costs.

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Subject: Approving the Second Amendment to the Agreement for Preliminary Engineering Reimbursement (Gas Line) with Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) for the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 Project

The cost for PG&E's preliminary engineering for the relocation of its 20" gas line was estimated to be approximately \$125,000. The Agreement committed RT to pay PG&E's actual costs (as presented by PG&E, with limited audit rights for RT) for preliminary engineering work, up to \$125,000.

In accordance with the Agreement, PG&E provided notice to RT in January that its costs have exceeded \$100,000 and will reach the \$125,000 cap prior to completion of preliminary design. On January 25, 2010, the Board approved the first amendment to the Agreement to increase the authorized reimbursement amount by \$61,000 from \$125,000 to \$186,000. PG&E provided notice to RT in March that its costs exceeded \$186,000 and requested an additional amendment for \$196,937.65 to complete the design for the Project.

PG&E requests an additional amount of \$196,937.65, for a total cost of \$383,937.65, due to the SSCP2 Environmental Amendment which requires the approval of additional property acquisitions for the project, the right of entry for RT and PG&E to complete the site analysis, additional schedule overhead for PG&E staff and their design consultants and the miscalculation of PG&E's professional services from 6% to 12% of the proposed construction estimate of \$3.2 M. (Industry standard for professional services is 10% to 15% of the proposed construction estimate.)

Staff recommends approval of the Second Amendment to the Agreement for Preliminary Engineering Reimbursement with Pacific Gas and Electric Company for the SSCP2 Project to add \$196,937.65 to the total consideration that may be paid to PG&E for preliminary engineering work.

THAT, the Second Amendment to the Agreement for Preliminary Engineering Reimbursement (Gas Line) between Pacific Gas and Electric Company, therein referred to as "PG&E," and the Sacramento Regional Transit District, therein referred to as "RT," whereby PG&E agrees to continue preliminary engineering work for relocation of its 20" gas pipeline as required for construction of the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 Project and RT agrees to increase the amount it will reimburse PG&E for PG&E's actual costs for such work by \$196,937.65, from \$186,000 to \$382,937.65, as further set forth therein, is hereby approved.

THAT, the Chair and General Manager/CEO are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Second Amendment.
