FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

DISCUSSION

Effective July 2011, all RT employees were moved into CalPERS benefit programs. As a consequence of that move, all benefit data must now be extracted from the CalPERS Automated Communications Exchange System (ACE) database. To complete data extracts, RT must enter into agreements with CalPERS (confidentiality and non-disclosure, etc.). The execution of such agreements was not anticipated and therefore was not covered by the authority granted to the General Manager/CEO in Issue Papers previously adopted by the Board of Directors.

Staff recommends the Board delegate authority to the General Manager/CEO to execute any necessary CalPERS agreements to complete data extracts from the CalPERS ACES database as needed to administer RT's Health and Welfare benefits program.
