#### DISCUSSION

RT entered into a contract with Retired RT employee, Bob Wenker on June 9, 2010 to work under the direction of RT's Video Infrastructure and Communications Enhancement (VICE) Project Manager.

The Contractor is providing logistical assistance to the Project Manager by preparing project schedules, written communications, reports, equipment requisitions, project billings, inventory management, asset tagging, equipment configuration, vendor communications and other project tasks as directed. Since the Contract will soon be exhausted and the work is not yet completed, the Contract needs to be amended to add funding to the Contract. Staff recommends that the Board approve the First Amendment to the Contract which increases the not-to-exceed amount of the Contract by \$50,000 to \$80,000.

The California Emergency Management Agency, which administers Federal Transit Security Grant Program (TSGP) funds in California, has communicated to RT that TSGP funds may not be used to replace the salary of existing RT personnel currently funded through RT's operating budget.
