## DISCUSSION

On September 14, 2009, the Board conditionally awarded the Design Build (D/B) Contract for the Minimal Operable Segment 1 (MOS 1) for the Downtown-Natomas-Airport Rail Corridor Project, now known as the Green Line to the River District Project (GL-1). Notice to Proceed was issued to the Stacy & Witbeck, Inc. (SWI) on November 30, 2009.

During the Traction Power Design phase of the project, multiple obstacles arose relating to the final location of a new Traction Power Sub-Station (TPSS) location. Those obstacles included operational, utility service and constructability issues and SWI and RT worked on options and alternatives to resolve and/or mitigate those obstacles.

As a result of this mitigation effort, SWI has asserted that it incurred additional engineering, surveying, and geotechnical costs relating to this work. RT staff reviewed the merits and costs associated with this work and determined, in negotiations with SWI, that SWI is entitled to additional compensation in the amount of \$136,000.00.

Staff recommends approval of CCO No. 020 in the amount of \$136,000.00.
