DISCUSSION

In December 2008, RT entered into a contract for temporary employment with Robert E. Kershaw to provide engineering support services for the bridges and structures for the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 (SSCP2) project (Project).

The Board approved three previous amendments to the Contract with Robert E. Kershaw, to extend the term and increase the total consideration due to the extension of the preliminary engineering design phase of the Project.

Mr. Kershaw is providing engineering support to the bridge design consultant, assisting in the review of bridge plans, specifications and cost estimates and will also provide construction support during construction for the Project. Mr. Kershaw has extensive experience in bridge and structures design, construction and construction management for both the public and private industry including highway and transit bridge structures.

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Approving the Fourth Amendment to Contract with Robert E. Kershaw Subject:

Since the SSCP2 Project schedule has been extended and the Aerial Structure Contract is being prepared for advertisement, Mr. Kershaw's technical expertise is needed during the bid period and construction phases of the Project through December 2013. To provide the level of effort required, the Contract total consideration must be increased by \$70,000, from \$209,000 to \$279,000.

Staff recommends Board approval of the fourth amendment to the contract with Robert E. Kershaw for Bridges and Structures Engineering Support of the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 Project to increase the total consideration by \$70,000 and extend the term by 2 years.
