Subject: Delegation of Authority to the General Manager/CEO to Approve and Execute all Utility Agreements

ISSUE

Whether or not to delegate authority to the General Manager/CEO or his designee to obtain public utility services from monopoly utility providers.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Adopt Resolution No. 11-09_____, Authorizing the General Manager/CEO or His Designee to Obtain Public Utility Services from Monopoly Utility Providers and to Execute Agreements Necessary to Obtain Such Services

FISCAL IMPACT

None, as a result of this action.

DISCUSSION

RT obtains utility services (natural gas, water and electricity) from utility companies that have a monopoly over the provision of those services. These services are needed for RT's day-to-day operations. Because of the monopolistic nature of these services, it would be fruitless to solicit competition, as would typically be required under RT's Procurement Ordinance. These providers may require utility agreements for the purpose of establishing service and setting rates for service. These rates are regulated by law and are non-negotiable.

Currently, each time RT establishes a new utility service, the RT Procurement Ordinance requires Staff to have the Board approve a contract that is non-negotiable. This can cause unnecessary delays to establish needed services. The General Manager/CEO needs the authority to obtain these services and execute necessary agreements in a timely manner to avoid lapses in utility service.

Staff is requesting authority be granted to the General Manager/CEO or his/her designee to obtain utility services from monopoly utility providers.
