#### **DISCUSSION**

As part of the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 Project (SSCP2) design, the Deer Lake Pedestrian Bridge is required to: (1) cross the existing Union House Creek Levee, (2) span the bufferlands and (3) connect to a bicycle/pedestrian path that leads to the proposed Franklin Light Rail Station. The preliminary design was rejected by the U.S. Army Corporation of Engineers (USCOE) and the Central Valley Flood Protection Board (CVFPB) due to the encroachment and penetration of the Union House Creek Levee. To avoid delay in receiving the CVFPB permit for SSCP2, this bridge work was removed from the permitted construction activities.

The Kimley Horn General Engineering Support Services (GESS) design team has the expertise and experience coordinating with the USCOE and CVFPB and can provide a final design acceptable to the USCOE/CVFPB and cost-effective to the SSCP2 project budget.
