Subject: Release of RFP for Breath Alcohol Testing and Urine Specimen Collection Services

ISSUE

Whether to approve the release of the Request for Proposal (RFP) for Breath Alcohol Testing and Urine Specimen Collection Services.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Adopt Resolution No. 12-02- , Approving the Release of the Request for Proposal for Breath Alcohol Testing and Urine Specimen Collection Services.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

DISCUSSION

In February 1994, the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) published regulations requiring breath alcohol testing and urine drug testing for all safety-sensitive employees of covered public transit service providers. Drug and alcohol testing is required as a condition of receiving federal funding and must be conducted in the following circumstances: pre-employment, upon reasonable suspicion, return to duty, follow-up, post-accident and random selection.

RT currently contracts with Collection Plus to provide breath alcohol testing and urine specimen collection services. The current contract will expire on June 30, 2012.

Staff recommends approval of the request to release the RFP for a firm to provide breath alcohol testing and urine specimen collection services for a period of four years.
