COMMENDING David Sander

Whereas, David Sander has faithfully represented the City of Rancho Cordova on the Sacramento Regional Transit District Board of Directors since January 2004; and

Whereas, David Sander led the Regional Transit Board of Directors during the absence of the Chair from November 9, 2004 through January 10, 2005, and served as Chair of the District for the remainder of 2005; and

Whereas, serving as Chair of the Board of Directors, David Sander demonstrated dedication and commitment to service on behalf of the residents of Sacramento, encouraging full participation in the discussion of all aspects in an expeditious manner; and

Whereas, during his tenure on the Regional Transit Board of Directors, David Sander has guided:

- The Successful Opening of the 7-Mile Light Rail Extension from the City of Rancho Cordova to the City of Folsom, Adding Seven Light Rail Stations, including Zinfandel, Cordova Town Center, Sunrise, Hazel, Iron Point, Glenn and Historic Folsom
- Adoption of the TransitAction Plan that Provides the Vision for the Next 25 Years of Public Transit Infrastructure Investments and Enhanced Public Transit Service Options for the Sacramento Region to Achieve Future Transportation Goals
- Passage of the "Weighted Voting" Legislative Initiative Providing Long-Term Governance Plan for the District
- A Nationwide Recruitment for Regional Transit's General Manager/CEO and a Statewide Recruitment for Regional Transit's Chief Legal Counsel
- Preparation of Cost Cutting Measures to Balance Regional Transit's Budget in the Face of Unprecedented State Budgetary Pressures on Transit Funding
- The District through the Most Severe Economic Recession in the District's History
- Approval of a Project Agreement with Capital Station 65 LLC for the 7th & Richards/Township 9 Station for the Green Line to the River District Light Rail Extension
- Support of Improvements to Transit Service in all Areas of Sacramento Including the Rancho CordoVan
- Construction on the Blue Line/Cosumnes River College Parking Structure in Preparation for the Future Blue Line to Cosumnes River College Light Rail Extension
- Implementation of a Universal Fare Card Program in Partnership with SACOG
- Improved Fare Recovery Ratio by 30%
- Installation of Electronic Message Signs at 19 Stations
- Adoption of the District's First Strategic Plan
- The Opening of the 8th & H/County Center Station; and

Whereas, during his term on the Regional Transit Board of Directors, David Sander generously shared his insights and expertise with the Board of Directors and the staff of Regional Transit.
