COMMENDING Jan Zolin

Whereas, Jan Zolin has faithfully represented persons with disabilities and older adults as the chair member of the Sacramento Regional Transit District, Mobility Advisory Council, from 2005; and

Whereas, Jan Zolin was appointed to serve as Chair of the Mobility Advisory Council by the Mobility Advisory Council; and

Whereas, the members of the Mobility Advisory Council were charged with providing advisory direction to the Sacramento Regional Transit District's Board of Directors regarding issues as they relate to persons with disabilities and older adults; and

Whereas, during Jan Zolin's term as Chair of the Mobility Advisory Council:

- Developed an Annual Work Plan to Link Accessibility Issues with Larger Customer-Oriented Decisions, such as Customer Information and Service Plans; and
- Recommended Revisions of the Bylaws to Streamline Mobility Advisory Council's Operations; and
- Provided Input on Seven Station Redesign and Improvement Projects, Including: 13th Street, 16th Street, 12th & I, Roseville Road, University/65th Street, Alkali Flat/La Valentina and the K Street Revitalization Project; and
- Provided Contributions and Insight on Various Projects and Plans, such as: TransitAction, TransitRenewal, Short Range Transit Plans, the Smart Card, as well as Formal Recommendations Pertaining to the ADA Paratransit Plan Update; and
- Offered Recommendations to the Board of Directors on Matters Impacting Persons with Disabilities and Older Adults in Light of Cost Cutting Measures to Balance Regional Transit's Budget in the Face of Unprecedented State and Local Budgetary Pressures on Transit Funding; and
- Gave Specific Input on Matters Impacting Passengers with Disabilities and Older Adults, such as: Passenger Information Signage, Priority Seating Passenger Announcements, iStops, Detectable Warning Tile at Grade Crossings, ADA Paratransit Certification, Paratransit Passenger Policies and Vehicle Design.

Whereas, serving as Chair of the Mobility Advisory Council, Jan Zolin demonstrated dedication and commitment to service on behalf of persons with disabilities and older adults, encouraging full participation in the discussion of all issues in an expeditious and civil manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:
