Mike Wiley noted that the appropriations committee within the House showed some movement on the Transportation and Housing Urban Development bill, but nothing more than he had already reported. At the State level, Mr. Wiley indicated that there was no definitive progress in regard to the High Speed Rail (HSP) level of funding and compromise between the Governor and Legislature. Diane Nakano will be representing RT at the California Transportation Commission meeting (CTC) and speaking on High Speed Rail on June 27th. The Governor is supporting an allocation of \$819 million in Proposition 1A Connectivity funds. Proposition 1A Connectivity funds, under the formula, will allocate \$30 million to Sacramento for improvement between our system and future HSR. RT will continue working with the CTC and will be pushing for a decision on June 27th. With respect to State budget, there were no impacts to transit.

Mr. Wiley provided an update on the events of the Green Line Grand Opening, and thanked the members of the Board, Chair Pannell, Directors Serna and Cohn, for speaking at the event. RT has received positive feedback on the use of the service. The Green Line is serving 200 to 300 passengers. Chair Pannell, Directors Cohn and Serna congratulated staff on the Green Line event.
