Subject: Awarding a Contract for UTDC Light Rail Vehicle Traction Motor Overhaul to Swiger Coil Systems, a Wabtec Company

The Engineer's estimate for the traction motor overhaul is \$480,000.

All bidders submitted a qualifications statement per the ITB requirements. Swiger Coil Systems re-manufactures more than 140 traction motors per month for dozens of transit agencies including San Francisco MUNI, BART, LA Metro, and Portland Transit.

The bid submitted by Swiger Coil Systems is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder and the bid price is fair and reasonable.

Pursuant to the revised Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) regulations in 49 C.F.R. Part 26 and RT's DBE Program, because there were limited subcontracting opportunities, no DBE participation goal was set for this procurement.

Staff recommends award of the Contract for UTDC Light Rail Vehicle Traction Motor Overhaul to Swiger Coil Systems, a Wabtec Company, in the amount of \$437,300, plus applicable sales tax.
