DISCUSSION

RT currently contracts with both the City and the County of Sacramento for Peace Officer Assignment for enhanced security on RT's buses, trains, and related transit facilities and rights of way. RT's Police Services Department is currently composed of 1 Police Lieutenant, 2 Police Sergeants, 15 Police Officers, 20 Police Volunteers, 1 Sheriff Sergeant, and 5 Sheriff Deputies.

The current agreement (Resolution #07-08-0091) with the County of Sacramento for Sheriff Deputy Services expires June 30, 2012. Staff proposes that RT enter into a new 3-year agreement for Sheriff Deputy Services, maintaining the current staffing levels with an option for extension for years four and five.

During the term of the agreement, RT may request additional Sheriff Deputies or other County employees, such as a Sheriff Lieutenant, Security Officer and/or On-Call Deputy at specified rates. RT requests for a Security Officer and/or On-Call Deputy will require an amendment to the Agreement to increase the total consideration.

Staff recommends the approval of the Agreement with the County of Sacramento for Sheriff Deputy Services.

**APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO
FOR SHERIFF DEPUTY SERVICES**

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL TRANSIT DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

THAT, the Contract with the County of Sacramento for Sheriff Deputy Services, therein referred to as "County," and Sacramento Regional Transit District, therein referred to as "RT," whereby County agrees to provide Sheriff Deputies, as specified, for a three-year term ending June 30, 2015 and for an amount not to exceed \$7,000,312.00, is hereby approved.

THAT, the Chair and General Manager/CEO are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract.
