DISCUSSION

On August 20, 2008, RT and Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc. (LAN) entered into the Contract for Civil, Track and Structures Design Services for the South Sacramento Corridor Phase II (SSCP2) Project. The SSCP2 Project is a 4.3-mile extension of the existing South Sacramento Corridor Phase I project, and will begin at Meadowview Station and end at Cosumnes River College.

Through ten prior Board-approved amendments, the allowable reimbursement amount was increased to \$9,102,751.32. The amendments covered additional geotechnical, environmental and survey work prior to the rainy season and dormant season for the giant garter snake, advancing preliminary engineering (PE) efforts, right of way engineering, additional hydraulics

analysis, realignment of the track along Morrison Creek, additional integration and coordination work, realignment of the track in the UPRR corridor, and ongoing utility coordination.

LAN has completed the advanced preliminary engineering design and cannot commence final design of the project until the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) allows RT to enter into Final Design. To allow LAN to promptly begin final design upon authorization for Final Design from FTA, Staff is requesting that the Board conditionally approve the Eleventh Amendment (contingent on FTA approval of entry into Final Design).

Staff recommends Board conditionally approve the Eleventh Amendment, in the amount of \$181,133.58, to the Contract for the South Sacramento Corridor Phase II Civil, Track and Structure Design Services with Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc.
