DISCUSSION

The Blue Line to Cosumnes River College project (Project), also known as the South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 project, will extend Sacramento Regional Transit District's (RT's) light rail service from its existing terminus at Meadowview Road south and east 4.3 miles to Cosumnes River College (CRC). The extension will link the South Corridor, the fastest-growing portion of Sacramento County, with Downtown, the northeast Sacramento corridor and Rancho Cordova or Folsom in the east corridor. The Project includes four stations: Morrison Creek, Franklin, Center Parkway, and CRC. Portions of the Project, including the Aerial Structures, are already under construction.

To accommodate the extended duration and phased federal approval of the SSCP2 project, RT advertised design contracts divided into three tasks. The design contracts were originally awarded for just Preliminary Engineering ("Task 1" in the contracts), with the remaining tasks left as options, to be added by amendment to the respective contracts. RT entered into contracts for design of the SSCP2 Project with four consultant teams for various aspects of the project to be included in the Civil, Track, Structures, Systems and Stations (CTSSS) construction contract currently out to bid. These contracts have been amended multiple times to gradually increase the scope of work through Final Design ("Task 2") and the conclusion of the CTSSS construction contract bidding.

Once the CTSSS contract is executed, RT will need the design consultants to provide design support during construction activities ("Task 3"). Based on the current understanding of the project, each of the design consultants has updated its respective proposal for Task 3 – Construction Support. The design teams have included updated labor rates and, in the case of the MFDB Architects team, updated indirect cost rates. In addition, additional scope has been added for LAN and MFDB to address some last-minute unanticipated design issues, including addressing comments during bidding from bidders, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), Freeport Regional Water Authority (FRWA), Los Rios Community College District (LRCCD), Pacific Gas & Electric Company (PG&E), and City of Sacramento. The total design support during construction for all consultant teams is estimated at \$3,341,410.98 for the entire duration of construction.

Due to cash flow issues, RT cannot fully fund all of the anticipated design support needed for the CTSSS construction contract at this time. The MFDB and Systra amendments will fund design

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support through December 31, 2013. The HLA amendment will fund support for 6 months. The LAN amendment will fund support for 12 months. Further amendments will be needed to continue the design support. The total cost of the short-term Task 3 amendments for all consultant teams would be \$1,477,677.17.

Staff recommends Board approval of the amendments to the Contracts for South Sacramento Corridor Phase 2 Design Services to add Task 3 – Construction Support for the first 6 - 12 months (depending on the consultant) of construction.
