DISCUSSION

On June 10, 2013, the Board authorized the release of an Invitation to Bid (ITB) for Elevator Maintenance and Repair Services. The ITB was for monthly preventive maintenance services and on-call repair services for 9 hydroelectric elevators, 1 dumbwaiter elevator, and 1 light rail station handicap lift as follows: Elevator #1, 1400 29th Street, Elevator #2, 1325 28th Street, Elevator #3, Watt Avenue & I-80 East, Elevator #4, Watt Avenue & I-80 West, Elevator #5, 2750 Academy Way, Elevator #6, 2670 Academy Way, Elevator #7, 2700 Academy Way, Elevator #8, 2900 Mather Field Road, Elevator #9, 1400 29th Street (Dumbwaiter), Elevator #10, 8th and Capitol (Wheelchair lift). The elevators were to be awarded individually, to the lowest bidders.

Staff released the ITB on June 24, 2013, advertised the solicitation in publications of general circulation and posted to RT's website under Contracting Opportunities. Ten contractors received

the ITB. In response, RT received five bids on July 26, 2013, from Capital Elevator Company, Inc.; Elevator Industries, Inc.; Elevator Technology Inc.; Otis Elevator Company and ThyssenKrup.

Otis Elevator Company submitted the lowest bid for the Watt/I-80 East and Watt/I-80 West elevators (Elevators #3 and #4); Elevator Industries, Inc. submitted the lowest bids for the remaining elevators (Elevators #1 and #2 and #5 through #10). After reviewing the bids, Staff determined that award of the Watt/I-80 East and Watt/I-80 West elevators should go to Otis Elevator Company; and award of the remaining elevators should go to Elevator Industries, Inc.

Staff recommends the Board award the Watt/I-80 East and Watt/I-80 West elevators to Otis Elevator Company for an amount not to exceed \$114,274.08 for 3 years.

Staff recommends the Board award the elevators at 1400 29th Street, 1325 28th Street, 2750 Academy Way, 2670 Academy Way, 2700 Academy Way, 2900 Mather Field Road, 1400 29th Street (Dumbwaiter), and 8th and Capitol (Wheelchair lift) to Elevator Industries, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$34,435 for 3 years
