DISCUSSION

RT is participating in a regional project led and funded by the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) called Connect Card, the purpose of which is to accomplish the implementation of a regional smart card fare system. The Connect Card system, once implemented, will involve the issuance of re-useable and electronically rechargeable fare media valid on all participating local transit agency service.

Communications upgrades to RT's bus fleets will be necessary to implement the Connect Card system. SACOG has agreed to provide the necessary funding for the purchase and installation of mobile access routers to be installed in RT's bus fleet to effect the upgrades necessary for the Connect Card system. Funding for this procurement has been provided through a subrecipient agreement between SACOG and RT.

A total of 285 mobile access routers are needed for installation on RT's fleet. In addition, RT is requesting a purchase option for up to an additional 200 units which may be exercised at a later date. These optional mobile access routers will be purchased for other local transit agencies participating in the Connect Card program. The purchase of the additional mobile access routers will be completely funded by SACOG for the Connect Card project.

To maintain the Connect Card project schedule and have the equipment available for installation in late July, staff is requesting the Board delegate authority to the General Manager/CEO to execute a contract for purchase and installation of the mobile access routers after the solicitation process has been completed and the lowest responsive and responsible bidder is identified.
