Subject: Authorize the Solicitation of Bids for the Purchase of 116 Light Rail Vehicle (LRV) Tire Kits

ISSUE

Whether or not to authorize the Solicitation of Bids for the Purchase of 116 LRV Tire Kits.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Adopt Resolution 14-12-____, Authorizing the Solicitation of Bids for the Purchase of 116 Light Rail Vehicle (LRV) Tire Kits.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action does not involve the expenditure of funds. The contract award, which will involve the expenditure of funds, will be presented to the Board as a future action.

DISCUSSION

RT needs to purchase 116 Light Rail Vehicle (LRV) Tire Kits. The tire kits will be used on both Siemens and CAF LRVs and are standard inventory items. LRV tire kits consist of a steel outer rim, electrical shunts and hardware. These tires are pressed on to a light rail vehicle axle per an RT required profile for transporting an LRV over 115 RE rails. The term “kit” is used to describe the referenced component parts.

The proposed procurement does not present any subcontracting possibilities. Therefore, in accordance with guidelines adopted by the RT Board of Directors, the ITB does not establish any Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goals.

Staff requests the Board authorize the solicitation of bids for purchase of 116 LRV Tire Kits.
