Subject: Informational Presentation of the CCJPA Vision Plan

ISSUE

To provide an overview of the Capitol Corridor Joint Powers Authority's (CCJPA) preparation of a vision plan for Capitol Corridor service.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

This is an information item, no action is being requested.

FISCAL IMPACT

None.

DISCUSSION

The Capitol Corridor provides intercity rail service between Auburn and San Jose. It is governed by the Capitol Corridor Joint Powers Authority, CCJPA, of which RT is a member. The CCJPA is in the process of preparing an update to their Vision Plan. The Vision Plan is a strategic planning document intended to guide the direction of Capitol Corridor service over the next 20 plus years. It is divided into short (0-10 years), medium (10-20 years) and long-term (20 plus years) with the long-term goal of a 1 hour travel time between Sacramento and Oakland. For the short term, the vision plan is consistent with the work being done on the blended service plan for high speed rail.

On June 24, 2013, Director Cohn requested that the Board be provided an update on the work that the CCJPA is doing to update the vision plan for Capitol Corridor intercity rail service. Mr. James Allison, Manager of Planning - CCJPA, will provide the requested update and answer questions.
