## Sacramento - Placerville Transportation Joint Powers Authority (JPA) May 21, 2014

After a brief discussion about the minutes and adopting a calendar for the next fiscal year, the meeting focused on the operating and capital budget. The operating budget was adopted at the same level as the previous year's budget. The contributions from the member agencies will remain the same as last year (\$27,500). The meeting then moved to the capital program.

This discussion centered on the Trail and trail head development. The approved project includes environmental and planning work with the option to begin construction of the trail head parking area as other aspects allow (complete planning and CEQA work). As a reminder, the design and work is for a joint use rail and trail corridor. This item had considerable public interest and a number of members of the public spoke regarding this item.

The JPA Board approved a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Sacramento for a property acquisition near Ramona. This property is along the right of way (ROW) adjacent to the existing JPA ROW. The City of Sacramento needs the property for a planned extension of Ramona Avenue. The City of Sacramento agrees to pay all costs and maintenance of the parcel. This action requires RT written consent prior to the JPA entering into the MOU with the City of Sacramento.
