# General Manager's Report September 8, 2014

## **GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS UPDATE**

## **FEDERAL**

The House and Senate were in recess and returned today. Congress will likely only be in session briefly (until the 19<sup>th</sup> (House) or 23<sup>rd</sup> (Senate)) with just enough time to enact a Continuing Resolution to prevent a government shutdown. Congress will next return to Washington following the November elections for a "Lame Duck" session and will have to enact a longer-term resolution to the FY15 budget situation.

## <u>STATE</u>

## **PEPRA Extension**

Led by the California Transit Association (CTA), the transit community successfully shepherded an important legislative measure through the process this August. AB 1783 (Sawyer-Jones) extends the present one-year PEPRA exemption for transit employees covered under the federal law until January 1, 2016. This effort was necessary because the pending legal action to maintain PEPRA through a determination by a federal court is not yet resolved and likely will not be this calendar year.

Following the amended bill emerging on August 18, the bill was maneuvered though three committee hearings and two floor votes leading to its final approval on August 29.

If approved by the governor, it is estimated that the provisions of the bill will avert more than \$1 billion in Federal Transit Agency (FTA) grants from being tied up.
