Subject: Approving Personal Service Contract Amendments for Audible Project Infrastructure and Hardware Installations, and Improvements for the Bus Maintenance Facility II Project

On January 17, 2014, RT awarded a Design and Specifications Contract to Enghouse Transportation to produce the specification documents and budget estimates needed to develop a formal bid package to procure the components necessary to install audible devices at light rail stations system-wide. Staff is currently working to develop additional software to manage the system and verify/test component performance, prior to full component procurement. The light rail station infrastructure needs have been identified and, while software efforts continue, staff would like to take advantage of this opportunity to move forward with the infrastructure improvements.

Additionally, in order to occupy the Bus Maintenance Facility II located at McClellan Park, staff will need to upgrade the facility. These upgrades include Division of the State Architect required fire and life safety elements and Americans with Disability Act (ADA) required modifications. Electrical service, which was required to be removed pursuant to the Fire Code, needs to be restored. A design work order for these activities is 90% complete. Once the design work is 100% complete, staff would like to begin tenant improvements. This work includes, but is not limited to: interior and exterior concrete/flat work; general tenant improvements in lighting, plumbing, electrical, carpentry, painting/finish work; general building demolition and repair; obtaining permits as necessary; and facility and equipment inspections.

In 2012 and 2014, the Board awarded Personal Service Contracts to William Harder, Glenn Keema, Liam Harder, Cody Keema, and Kirk Naranong for Smart Card Project infrastructure and hardware installations. The individuals identified above are referred to as the "Crew". The Crew has performed very well and has made excellent progress with the Smart Card and Dynamic Messaging Sign projects.

Given prior performance, light rail system knowledge and journeyman level construction skills, Staff would like to expand the scope of the current Contracts to include activities associated with the new audible system, including the following tasks: above and below grade installations of conduit, pull boxes, data, power, speakers and miscellaneous infrastructure and equipment.

Additionally, Staff would like to add scope associated with the Bus Maintenance Facility II Project which includes, but is not limited to: interior and exterior concrete/flat work; general tenant improvements in lighting, plumbing, electrical, carpentry, painting/finish work; general building demolition and repair; obtaining permits as necessary; and facility and equipment inspections.

The Crew will continue to work on the Connect Card Project as well.

To accomplish all of the work listed above, Staff recommends that the Board extend the Contract expiration date for each of the PSC amendments to December 31, 2015, amend the scope of work, and increase the total consideration.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the PSC Amendments for William Harder, Glenn Keema, Liam Harder, Cody Keema, and Kirk Naranong, for Audible Project infrastructure and hardware installations, and improvements for the Project.
