This action does not involve the expenditure of funds. The contract award, which will involve the expenditure of funds, will be presented to the Board as a future action.

DISCUSSION

Regional Transit first established an Employee Assistance Program (EAP) in 1984. The program provides confidential counseling and referral services to employees and their dependents on matters that may affect job performance. Services include counseling for alcohol and drug abuse, gambling, marital, family, medical, emotional, financial and legal problems. The EAP also provides guidance and training for supervisors and managers on handling difficult personnel problems.

On December 13, 2010, the RT Board awarded a contract for EAP Services to MHN, Inc., for a 3-year term, with the option to renew for two additional 1-year terms. The contract was made effective January 1, 2011; both option years were exercised and the final contract will expire on December 31, 2015. RT staff desires to enter into another EAP contract that will be effective on January 1, 2016 to maintain continuity of services and to minimize service disruption to employees using the EAP.

Staff recommends the Board approve the release of an RFP for Employee Assistance Program for a 3-year term with the option to renew for two additional 1-year terms.
