Subject: Officially Repealing Superseded Ordinances

ISSUE

Whether or not to repeal outdated and superseded ordinances relating to procurement.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Adopt Resolution 15-11-___, Repealing Ordinances 81-1, 83-1, 85-1, 87-1, 89-1, 05-03-01, Relating to Procurement.

FISCAL IMPACT

DISCUSSION

Since RT's formation, RT has had an administrative code, adopted through ordinances, setting out its procurement processes and procedures. The current ordinance was adopted in 2013 (Ordinance 13-11-01) and fully states all of RT's Board-adopted requirements with respect to procurement.

In reviewing RT's ordinances, Staff determined that there were a number of ordinances affecting RT's procurement activities that were not officially repealed, even though they were entirely superseded by later Board action. To avoid confusion, Staff is recommending that these obsolete ordinances be officially repealed.
