DISCUSSION

Over the past 15 years, RT has purchased various hardware systems and software applications from Clever Devices, Inc. for transit systems operations. Examples of these systems and applications are: on-board computer systems for automated passenger counting, automated vehicle location, on-time performance, schedule adherence, and bus arrival prediction for transit operations.

Annual software maintenance for these systems has been purchased by RT under the General Manager/CEO's authority to award contracts under \$100,000. This year however, the aggregate total of software maintenance costs for all Clever Devices hardware and software products in use by RT exceeds \$100,000.

This year, for the first time, the annual software maintenance fees exceed \$100,000, which has prompted Staff to reexamine the annual software maintenance fees and the mechanism applied to approve and process payment.

Because payment of the annual maintenance fees are necessary to maintain the functionality of the hardware and software, and because the hardware and software is proprietary and can only be maintained by Cleve Devices and, for these reasons, is not a discretionary expenditure, Staff is requesting that the Board delegate authority to the General Manager/CEO to continue paying the annual support fee to Clever Devices, Inc. for so long as RT continues to use the hardware system and software applications provided by Clever Devices, Inc.
