ISSUE

Whether to approve an Agreement for Acquisition of Easement and Temporary Construction Easement for the City of Sacramento to construct an extension of Ramona Avenue south of Folsom Boulevard.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Adopt Resolution No. 16-12-____, Approving an Agreement for Acquisition of Easement and Temporary Construction Easement for the City of Sacramento to Construct an Extension of Ramona Avenue South of Folsom Boulevard.

FISCAL IMPACT

Approval of the Easement Agreement would result in RT receiving a total one-time fee of \$1,000.

DISCUSSION

The City of Sacramento (City) has requested an easement to construct an extension of Ramona Avenue within a portion of RT's property.

This property is located in the vicinity of Ramona Avenue and Folsom Boulevard (APN: 015-0033-008) and is further identified in Attachments A and B.

The City will extend Ramona Avenue from its existing terminus at Brighton Avenue to a new intersection at Folsom Boulevard. RT will grant the City an Easement under the Brighton Bridge to complete the Ramona Avenue extension from Brighton Avenue to Folsom Boulevard. The project is a separated grade crossing that will not impact RT's operations. The extension of Ramona Avenue will improve pedestrian and vehicular connectivity to the north and south of Highway 50.


The City would be solely responsible for the construction, use, operation, repair and maintenance of public right of way. Installation of the public improvements will not interfere with RT's operations. The City has requested a 1 year Temporary Construction Easement to construct the project.


