### DISCUSSION

In November 2015, RT released an Invitation to Bid (ITB) for an emergency backup generator to be used as backup for Information Technology (IT) servers and Bus Dispatch in case of a power failure. The ITB requested bids from contractors to furnish and install all necessary materials, labor and equipment for an emergency power generator for RT's Administration Building located at 1400 29<sup>th</sup> Street in accordance with the Technical Specifications and Plans. The work includes, but is not limited to, trenching, backfilling, concrete removal and replacement, providing and installing a concrete pad, fencing, generator, automatic transfer switch, and providing diesel fuel.

On January 22, 2016, RT received 6 bids. The bids were as follows:

- 1. Bockmon & Woody Electric \$155,033
- 2. Cabar Electric \$198,500
- 3. TSI Engineering \$214,786
- 4. Lords Electric \$218,400
- 5. DMZ Builders \$236,000
- 6. Big Valley Electric \$258,000

The solicitation was advertised in publications of general circulation and posted on RT's website under Bidding Opportunities. It is RT's policy that Small Business Enterprises ("SBEs") (defined as a business that has been certified as a small business by the California Department of General Services or any other public agency that certifies small businesses under applicable laws), will have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of this Contract. To further that policy, a 25% SBE contract goal was set for this Contract. Bidders meeting the 25% SBE participation goal were eligible to receive a 5% price preference. The apparent low bidder for the subject project is not an SBE certified firm. The other 5 bidding firms are SBE certified firms. Based on the low bid amount of \$155,033.00 the 5% price preference amount was calculated at \$7,751.65. The spread between the apparent low bidder and the 2nd low bidder was \$43,467.00. The application of the 5% price preference did not change the rank order of the bids, leaving Bockmon & Woody Electric Co, Inc. the apparent low bidder.

The engineer's estimate for the project is \$230,000. The low bid for the project of \$155,033 is 32.6% below the engineer's estimate and is determined to be fair and reasonable. Staff has determined that Bockmon & Woody Electric Co, Inc. is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Therefore, staff recommends that Bockmon & Woody Electric Co, Inc. be awarded the Contract to provide and install a backup emergency generator at RT's Administration building for the not to exceed amount of \$155,033.
