*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington was responsible for management of the Sacramento Regional Transit District's Planning and Transit System Development (Planning, Customer Advocacy and Accessible Services departments), advising staff and the Board of Directors on matters directly relating to these areas; and

*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington led the effort for the adoption of the District's updated Strategic Plan and TransitAction Plan; and

*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington has led the Planning and Transit System Development Division with creative and innovative solutions to difficult issues facing the District; and

*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington amended the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Paratransit Eligibility Certification Provisions of the ADA Paratransit Plan; and

*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington amended the District's Title VI Program Update; and

*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington implemented TransitRenewal, the first phase of the long-range Transit Master Plan, TransitAction; and

*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington has guided the environmental review and project development of the Green Line to the Airport light rail extension project, making it possible to build the first phase to the River District; and

*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington has been an active member of the American Public Transportation Association, and served on the Boards for the North Natomas Transportation Management Association, Del Paso Boulevard and Watt Avenue Property Based Improvement Districts, the North Franklin Business District, and the Sacramento Black Chamber of Commerce; and

*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington has faithfully served the best interests of the District as a valued member of the District's Executive Management Team; and

*Whereas*, RoseMary Covington will retire from the Sacramento Regional Transit District on February 1, 2016.
