Subject: First Amendment to the Contract with the City of Folsom for Peace Officer Assignment

ISSUE

Whether or not to approve the First Amendment to the Contract with the City of Folsom for Peace Officer Assignment.

*Only \$45,000, approximately 6 months, of the contract amount is budgeted. The contract will be re-evaluated in November 2016.

DISCUSSION

Currently, RT has a total of 29 sworn law enforcement officers (LEO) that make up RT's Police Services Department (RTPS). Of the 29 sworn LEOs, 6 are assigned to RT under a separate contract with the County of Sacramento and 22 are assigned to RT under contract with the City of Sacramento.

Under the General Manager/CEO's authority, RT entered into a one year contract with the City of Folsom for Peace Officer Assignment to commence on August 10, 2015. The City of Folsom agreed to assign a police officer to RT for increased security on RT's buses, trains, and related transit facilities and rights of way.

The City of Folsom has agreed to pay for one-half of the officer's salary, health insurance and related benefits so long as RT pays for the remaining half. The City also agreed that it would provide a vehicle for the officer so long as RT pays for the fuel for the vehicle.

The addition of Officer Simpson has benefited RT in a number of ways. Simpson brings his knowledge and experience from the City of Folsom to the Folsom Light Rail extension (Iron Point, Glenn and Historic Folsom) along with the rest of the RT light rail and bus system. Also, Simpson

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has seamlessly interacted and joined projects with Sacramento Police Officers and Sacramento Sheriff Deputies (assigned to RT) such as the bait bike project at various light rail stations.

The current Contract expires June 30, 2016. Staff is proposing to extend the Contract for one year, ending June 30, 2017, plus options for two more one-year extensions. Staff recommends the approval of the Contract with the City of Folsom for Peace Officer Assignment.
