FISCAL IMPACT

Approval of authority to receive funds will enable RT to access Prop 1B Transit Security funding in the amount of \$1,625,197.

DISCUSSION

In January 2016, RT filed applications with Cal OES for State Proposition 1B FY 2015-16 California Transit Security Grant Program (CTSGP) California Transit Assistance (CTAF) funds for the following projects:

- Phone System Replacement \$305,250
- Track Warrant Controlled Access System \$187,450
- Upgrades to Transit Security Systems \$15,480
- Radio Communication System Upgrades \$1,117,017

Cal OES has determined that the projects listed above are eligible for FY 2015-16 CTSGP-CTAF funding. All projects will be funded with the same grant.

Cal OES notified RT that it must provide a Board resolution identifying RT's authorized representative to accept the grant and execute the grant documents necessary to receive the grant funds, which are expected to become available in winter 2016-17.

Budgets for these capital projects in the amounts noted above will be included in RT's FY 2017 Abridged Budget document.
