COMMENDING

Mike Mattos

Whereas, Mike Mattos was hired as the Facilities Manager on February 11, 2002; appointed as Acting Chief of Facilities Management on July 1, 2003; promoted to Chief of Facilities on September 1, 2003; and Chief of Facilities and Business Support Services on January 1, 2005; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos was responsible for management of the Sacramento Regional Transit District's Facilities and Business Support Services (Facilities, Information Technology, Procurement and Safety departments), advising staff and the Board of Directors on matters directly relating to the support services of the District; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos was a valuable member of the District's Executive Management Team that successfully guided the District through the great recession; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos continually sought out revenue sources to enhance the District's financial condition such as the Park, Pay and Ride program, selling Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) to other entities, and the Low Carbon Fuel Standard Credits; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos completed the installation of security cameras at all of the District's light rail stations; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos took steps to keep the District's CNG fueling system operational with minimal down time; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos opened the District's second CNG fueling facility; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos implemented the college and high school internship programs; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos installed fiber optics throughout the District partnering with regional public entities; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos installed electronic messaging signs at all light rail stations; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos was instrumental in the procurement of a Transit Watch Mobile application; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos launched the pilot program for the District's Mobile Ticket Application for fare purchase; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos supported extending light rail to Folsom, Sacramento Valley Station, Township 9, and the Blue Line to Meadowview and Cosumnes River College; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos negotiated new and expanded Maintenance Agreements with the Midtown Business Association; Downtown Sacramento Partnership; Power Inn Alliance; Mack Road Partnership; and the City of Rancho Cordova; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos helped organize the District's charity programs benefiting Special Olympics, United Way and Breathe California of Sacramento-Emigrant Trails; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos has led the Facilities and Business Support Services Division with creative and innovative solutions to difficult issues facing the District; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos has faithfully served the best interests of the District as a valued member of the RT Executive Management Team; and

Whereas, Mike Mattos retired from the Sacramento Regional Transit District on February 1, 2016.

That, the Board of Directors does hereby express its appreciation for the support and dedication that Mike Mattos has provided during his 14 years of service; and
