Subject: Authorizing Staff to Dispose of 66 Surplus Revenue Vehicles in Accordance with the Sacramento Emergency Clean Air and Transportation (SECAT) Program Agreement

## **ISSUE**

Whether or not to authorize staff to dispose of 66 surplus revenue vehicles in accordance with the Sacramento Emergency Clean Air and Transportation (SECAT) Program Agreement

### RECOMMENDED ACTION

Adopt Resolution 16-05-\_\_\_\_, Authorizing Staff to Dispose of 66 Surplus Revenue Vehicles in Accordance with the Sacramento Emergency Clean Air and Transportation (SECAT) Program Agreement

### FISCAL IMPACT

RT will receive up to \$2,203,213 from the SECAT Program based on surrendering 66 surplus revenue vehicles for destruction at a rate of up to \$33,382 per vehicle. Proceeds from disposal of the vehicles will be used to fund replacement buses, replacing currently-budgeted RT Revenue Bonds. The Revenue Bonds would then be available to fund other priority RT projects.

#### **DISCUSSION**

RT has entered into a Sacramento Emergency Clean Air and Transportation (SECAT) Program Agreement with Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) and Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District (SMAQMD). One of the air quality improvement methods identified in the SECAT Program, which was established by the state legislature, is the development of a Fleet Modernization Program to promote the advance purchase and use of low-NOx on-road heavy-duty vehicle and engine technology. The objective of the Program is to accelerate the modernization of the existing heavy-duty vehicles in the Sacramento Federal Ozone Nonattainment Area through finance incentives that will encourage the voluntary purchase of heavy-duty vehicles using newer, lower emitting technology or alternative fuels, and the retrofitting of existing heavy-duty vehicle engines with technology that lowers engine emissions. Under the Program, SMAQMD and SACOG provide financial incentives to vehicle owners that agree to surrender their vehicles for destruction.

RT Procurement Ordinance, Sections 2.102 and 2.103 set out the procedure for disposal of surplus property. Staff is requesting Board approval to waive the requirements of RT Procurement Ordinance, Sections 2.102 and 2.103, to participate in the SECAT Program for disposal of 66 surplus revenue vehicles.

The list below identifies the 66 revenue vehicles that are included in the SECAT Program Agreement. The disposal value is based on calculating the "Anticipated Annual NOx Reduction."

Selling the vehicles, as required by RT Procurement Ordinance, Section 2.102, would result in total revenue of \$46,200 based on a sales price of approximately \$700 per vehicle. The \$700 price estimate is from a recent sale of surplus revenue vehicles. The resulting revenue for all 66 vehicles would be \$2,157,013 less than the revenue that would result from participation in the SECAT Program.

Therefore, staff recommends the Board's authorization for staff to dispose of 66 surplus revenue vehicles, as they reach the end of their serviceable life, in accordance with the SECAT Program.
