Subject: Authorizing Solicitation of Proposals for Streetcar Vehicle Maintenance and Service Facility Design Services

## ISSUE

Whether or not to authorize solicitation of proposals for Streetcar Vehicle Maintenance and Service Facility Design Services.

## RECOMMENDED ACTION

Adopt Resolution No. 17-04-\_\_\_\_\_, Authorizing Release of Request for Proposals for Streetcar Vehicle Maintenance and Service Facility Design Services.

## FISCAL IMPACT

The above action does not involve the expenditure of funds. The contract award, which will involve the expenditure of funds, will be presented to the Board as a future action. Award of the design contract will be contingent on RT having a funding agreement in place under which SACOG and the Cities of Sacramento and West Sacramento will fund the design work.

## DISCUSSION

The Downtown/Riverfront Streetcar project includes 3.3-mile initial line that will extend from the West Sacramento Civic Center to the Midtown entertainment and retail district in the City of Sacramento. This initial streetcar line leverages many of the existing shopping, dining, lodging and entertainment destinations as well as employment centers within the cities of West Sacramento and Sacramento. The line will operate with modern double-articulated streetcars, and must be built within a Small Starts budget of \$150 million to \$200 million. The project is a partnership with Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG), the cities of Sacramento and West Sacramento, Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT), Yolo County Transportation District (YCTD) and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

The current Downtown/Riverfront Streetcar project contemplates a Vehicle Maintenance and Service Facility (VMSF) dedicated to the streetcar vehicles, to be located under U.S. Highway 50 on either the West Sacramento or Sacramento side of the river, depending on the amount of funding available to the project.

On April 25, 2016, the RT Board of Directors awarded a contract for Downtown Riverfront Streetcar Design Services to HDR, Inc. The contract with HDR included an option (Task 4) for site design of the VMSF, which was awarded by the Board on January 23, 2017. The contract with HDR does not include the design of the building itself, which requires a different set of expertise and would be developed on a different time line.
