GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS UPDATE

STATE

Transportation Plan, Next Steps

Following the approval by both houses of the Legislature of SB 1 (Beall) on April 6th, there is still legislative work needed to complete the transportation funding package.

As a reminder, SB 1 will raise \$52.4 billion over the next 10 years and will be accompanied by a constitutional amendment to protect the new revenues incorporated in the package. Of the \$52.4 billion estimated to be available over a ten-year period, included is almost \$9 billion for public transit and active transportation, with significant new revenues to be dedicated to Sacramento RT.

However, there are two bills that are also considered to be "key companion" measures to SB 1, SB 132 (Budget Committee) and SB 496 (Cannella/DeLeon). These bills were both just were approved by the Senate on Wednesday, April 19th and are scheduled to be considered by the Assembly on April 20th. While these two bills are moving through the process, SB 1 has been retained at the Senate Desk, to be released to Governor Brown when the two companion bills are approved.

It is anticipated that this schedule will facilitate a bill-signing by Governor Brown mid-to late next week.

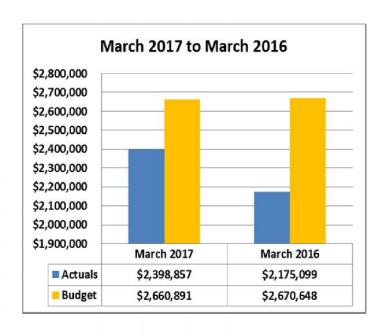

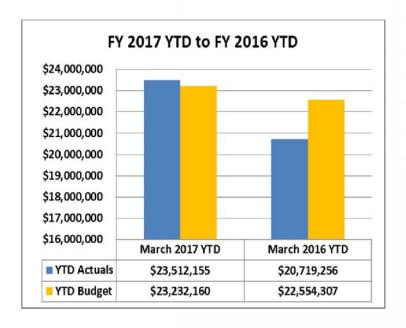

Fare Revenue Comparison

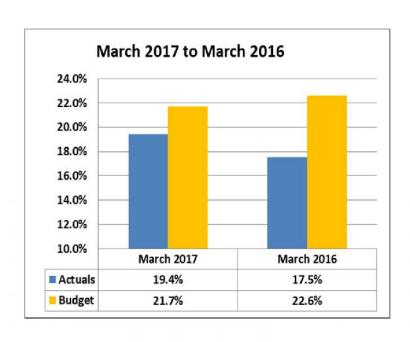


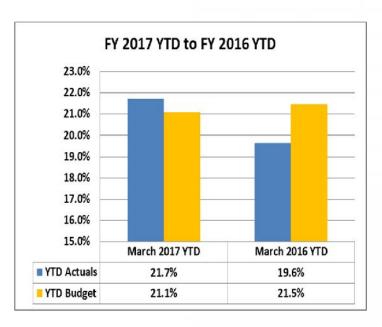
