DISCUSSION

Otis Elevator Company provides elevator maintenance and repair for the elevators at the Watt/I-80 light rail station under a five-year contract that expires on September 4, 2018. The contract maximum of \$207,000.00 has been reached, but additional repairs will be necessary through the end of the contract term. This third amendment is to add funding to cover ongoing scheduled preventive maintenance and for future repairs due to the likelihood of additional breakdowns.

The elevators are nearing the end of their useful life, and maintenance upkeep on the elevators is frequent. The elevators are approximately 20 years old and the availability of parts is limited and the lead time has been up to a few weeks. Further, these are outdoor elevators that are open to the public via the station and Watt Avenue and frequently vandalized. It has been difficult to find an elevator company that is willing to service these elevators other than Otis Elevator Company.

In addition to the repair services, the elevator is now locked during non-service hours and security is assigned to the station during service hours in order to help prevent further damage to the existing elevator.
