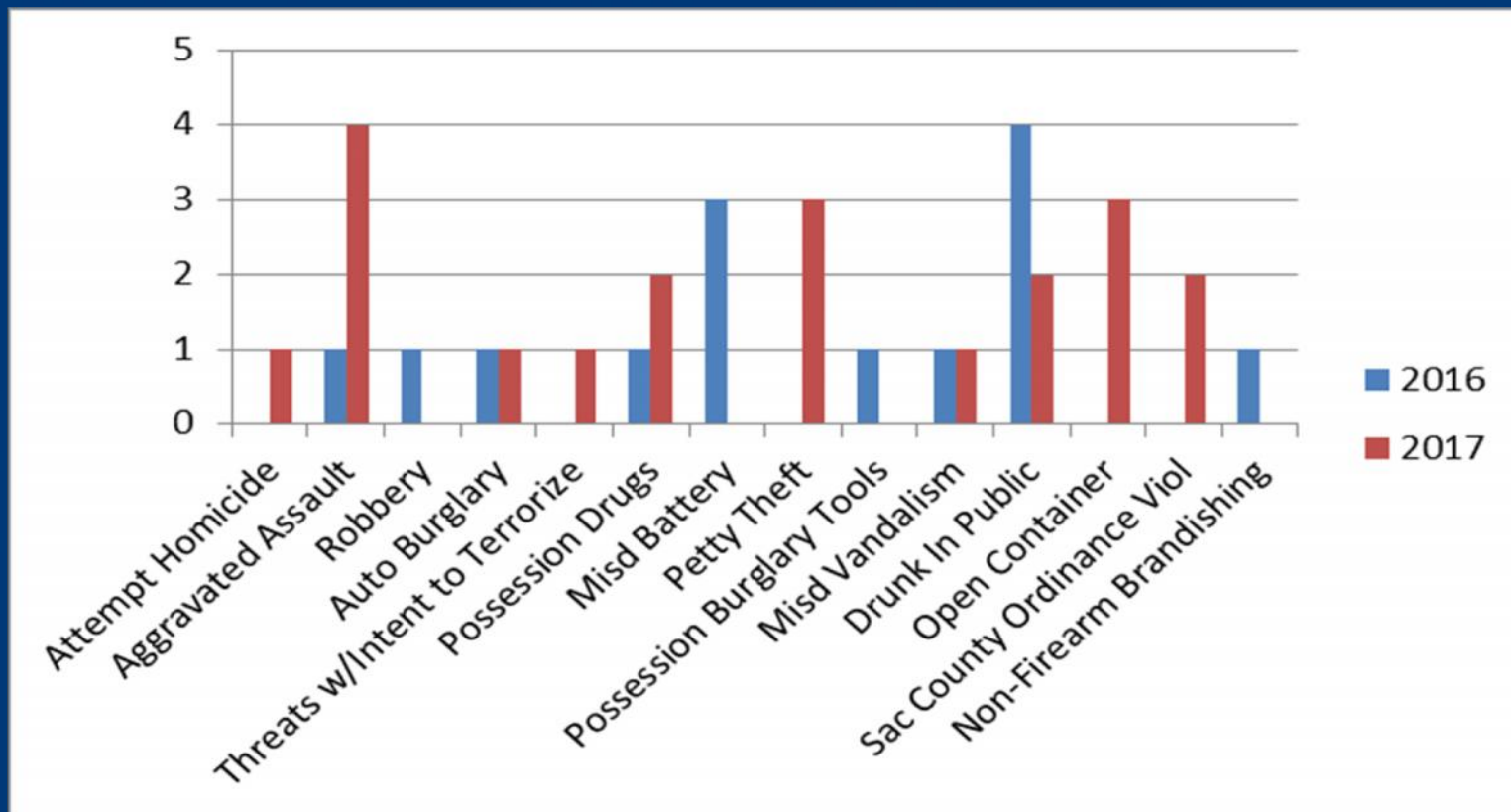

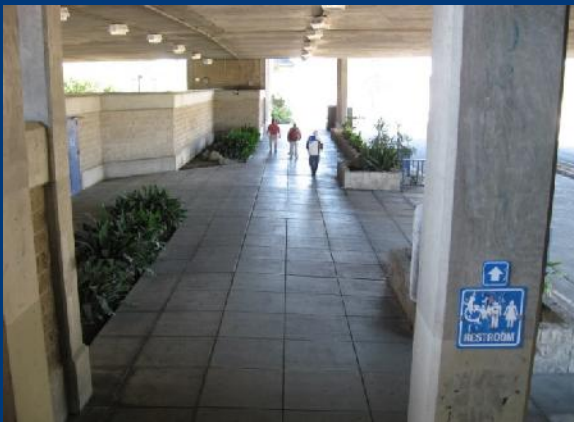

Watt/I-80 Transit Master Plan



- Develop conceptual multi-modal master plan
- WalkSacramento to conduct outreach, lead charrette, walk audits, intercept surveys and focus groups
- Assess access, bike/pedestrian connectivity, transit service access/needs, safety and security
- Expected outcomes are:
 - list of potential improvements
 - phasing and funding plan
 - compilation of data to pursue funding (safety, health, access, outreach efforts, state of facilities, ridership increase potential)
- Schedule:
 - Outreach: Fall 2017
 - Technical work/draft report: Winter 2017
 - Complete: February 2018
