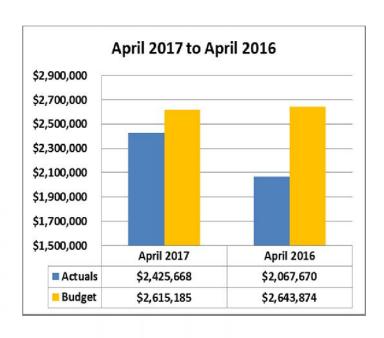

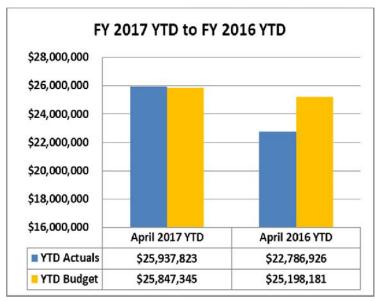

# Fare Revenue Comparison

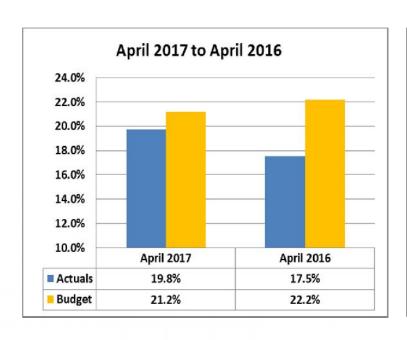


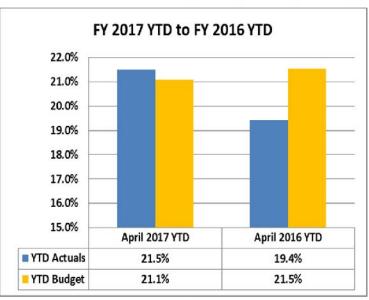
