## DISCUSSION

SacRT contracts with both the City and the County of Sacramento and with the City of Folsom for Peace Officer Assignment for enhanced security on SacRT's buses, trains, and related transit facilities and rights of way. SacRT's Police Services Department (RTPS) is authorized to have up to (1) Police Captain, (1) Police Lieutenant, (2) Police Sergeants, (18) Police Officers, (1) Sheriff Sergeant, (5) Sheriff Deputies, and (1) Folsom Police Officer.

On June 12, 2017, the Board approved a five-year agreement (Resolution No. 17-06-0069) with the County of Sacramento for Sheriff Deputy Services. During the term of this agreement, SacRT may request additional Sheriff Deputies as SacRT needs. SacRT is requesting the addition of 1 Sheriff Deputy assigned specifically for the policing of the Rancho Cordova Light Rail Stations. The Rancho Cordova Police Department (RCPD) has agreed to pay for one-half of the officer's salary, health insurance and related benefits so long as SacRT pays for the remaining half for a trial period of one year.

The total maximum cost (salary, health insurance and related benefits) of 1 RCPD Officer is \$211,267 (RCPD pays for one-half and SacRT pays for the other one-half) based on the position's top step with assumptions for possible increases which may occur during labor negotiations. The

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billing will reflect the actual officer rates and hours worked. The Police Captain position is currently vacant and the savings from that position will fund the RCPD Officer.

Staff recommends the approval of the First Amendment to the Agreement with the County of Sacramento for Sheriff Deputy Services.
