DISCUSSION

Approximately 13 years ago, SacRT selected a set of peer transit agencies against whom SacRT would conduct comparisons for its financial documents. The peers consist of transit agencies found throughout the United States that have comparable bus or rail systems. Although not a Federal or State requirement, on-going peer analysis is a valuable tool used to identify organizational strengths and weaknesses and measure improved performance against external benchmarks.

Subject: Revising Peer Agency Group for Best Practices Comparison Purposes

Recently while examining the data, we determined that the criteria used in the past did not consider the important fact that the non-California agencies may be located in lower cost of living areas and are often subject to different regulations. Therefore, using non-California agencies for cost comparison purposes is not reasonable. Some of these regulations differences include: SacRT being subject to no tort liability cap while other states may have limits as low as \$500,000 per occurrence, more aggressive and earlier enacted pension reform, and environmental compliance costs.

Based on these reasons, it would be more accurate to use peer transit agencies found within California. Therefore, for future financial documents, such as the budget and comprehensive annual financial report, we will be using the following agencies below for comparison purposes. This would not affect peers that may be selected by outside agencies that do audits or reviews of SacRT as they may have to follow different criteria and guidelines.
