DISCUSSION

On October 13, 1993, the Regional Transit Board of Directors approved joining the Sacramento Regional Radio Communications System (SRRCS), the countywide public safety radio system. Since that time, SacRT has fully integrated the County-managed Motorola radio system into its bus and rail fleet and day-to-day operations. On July 1, 2010, SacRT renewed its licensing agreement with the SRRCS through July 1, 2020.

As part of the Licensing Agreement, all SRRCS participants share the annual operating costs of the shared radio system; however, each is directly responsible for maintenance and replacement of unshared system components, such as individual radios and dispatch consoles.

The existing Motorola mobile radios in SacRT's CAF light rail fleet have become obsolete and are in need of replacement. The County radio system is a proprietary Motorola system and will not interoperate with mobile radio equipment from other equipment manufacturers.

Staff recommends approving the sole source procurement of Motorola mobile radio consoles and awarding a contract for their purchase and installation.

APPROVING A SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT AND AWARDING A CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF MOBILE RADIO EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 1.405.b. of the SacRT Procurement Ordinance, a sole source procurement is permitted upon a determination that the required product is only available from the manufacturer and a finding that it would be futile to seek competition; and

WHEREAS, SacRT has participated in a regional radio system since 1993 to ensure effective communications in emergency situations and the regional radio system is proprietary equipment manufactured by Motorola; and

WHEREAS, some of the existing equipment is obsolete and requires replacement; and

WHEREAS, because Motorola is the only manufacturer that can provide equipment that integrates into SacRT's existing system, it would be futile to seek competitive bids for Motorola's proprietary equipment.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL TRANSIT DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

THAT, pursuant to Section 1.405.b of SacRT's Procurement Ordinance, sole source procurement is authorized because the proprietary nature of the radio system precludes competition.

THAT, the Board hereby authorizes the sole source procurement and awards a Contract to Motorola, Inc. for the purchase and installation of mobile radio equipment for an amount not to exceed \$300,000, plus applicable sales tax.
